Emergency Operations Plan

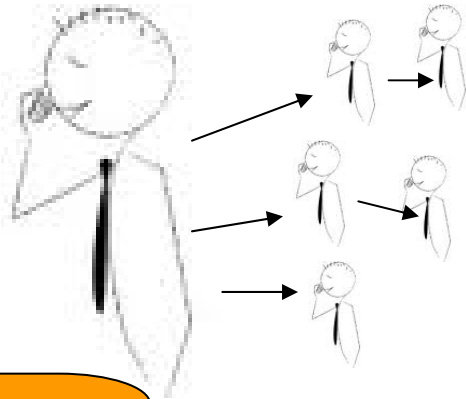
- Plan Adopted: October 13, 2009
- Formalized plan of action
- Who is responsible for what & when
- Federal funding/reimbursement
- **Working towards same goal**



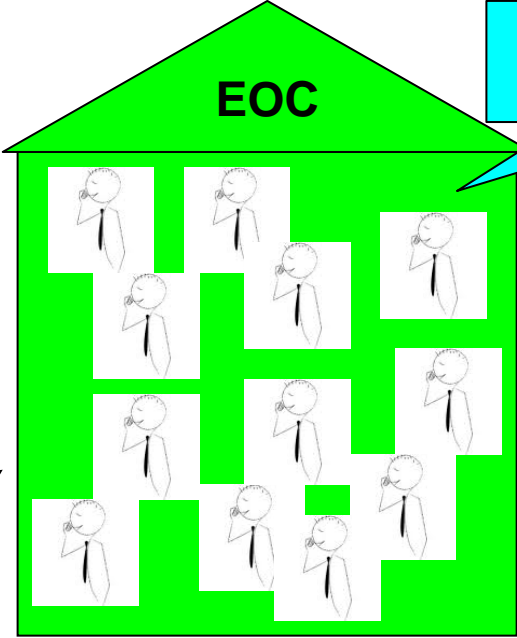
The Disaster Cycle



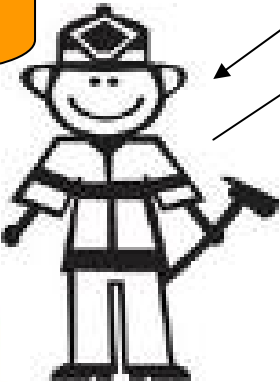
We need to activate the EOC

Activated EOC

- Assist Incident Command by providing resources to manage incident
- Facilitate the management of response
- Reduce consequences of the incident
- Begin recovery process as quickly as possible
- Provide a link to the next level of government



Role of the Block Captain

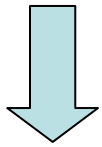
- Responsible for no more than 10 homes
- Gather information
- Communicate with the EOC
- Take info back to the residents on your block



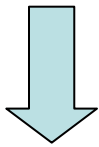

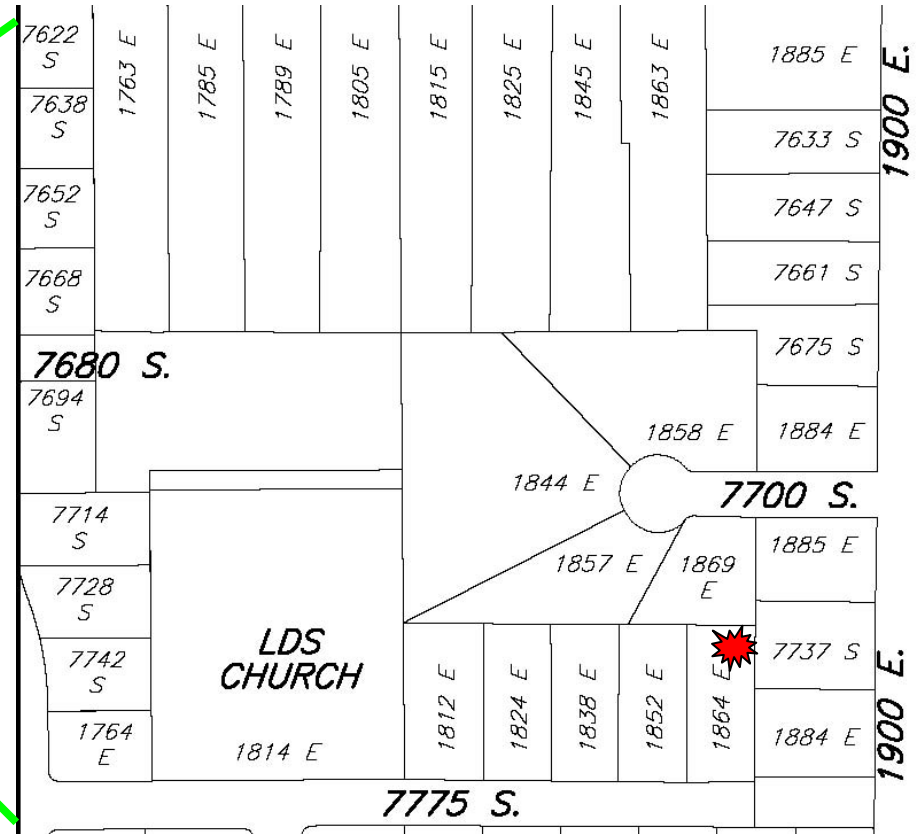
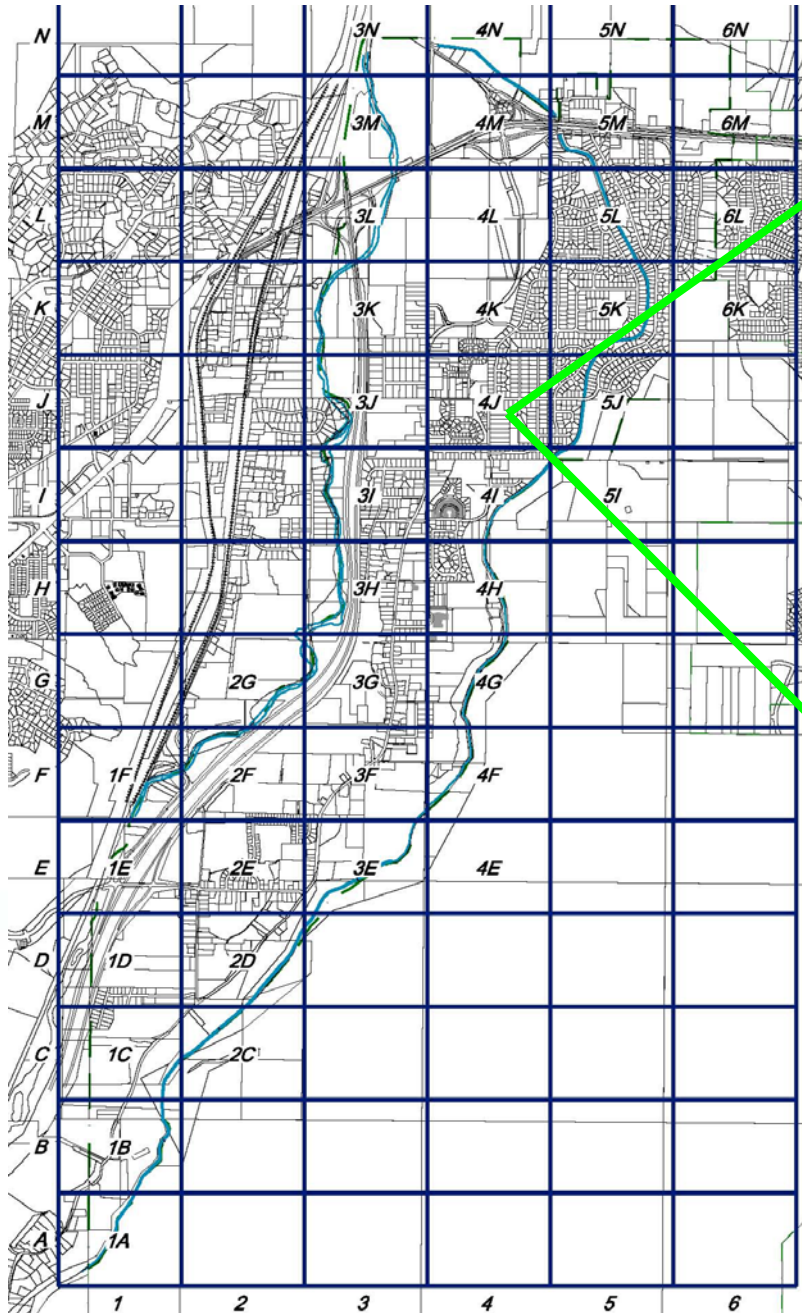








Initial Walk Report

- Look, Listen, Smell
- Are people okay?
- "I'm here only to gather info & pass along to those who can help you."
- Gather special needs information about people in house
 - Ideally done prior to an event
- Move on to next house
