Weber Basin Water Conservancy District has reminded us that we have had an exceptionally dry summer and encourages residents to continue to conserve water. As fall approaches, remember to cut back on the amount of water you give your lawns, many need only to water once or twice a week. In fact, less water on your lawns during this time will allow the roots to stretch deeper and become stronger!

You can also conserve water indoors: wash only full loads of clothes and match the water level to the size of the load and keep a pitcher of water in your fridge instead of running your water until it is cold enough to drink.

Your efforts to conserve water are greatly appreciated. Please continue to be mindful of these things so that we will not have a concern about our water supply next year.

WINTER MONTHS PARKING REGULATIONS REMINDER

A friendly reminder that between the months of November (beginning November 1st) and March (ending March 31st) there is no parking allowed on city streets between the hours of midnight until noon. 6.01.040(D)(9)

Specific Months Restricted: It shall be unlawful to park a vehicle or recreational vehicle or farm equipment on any street in the city between the hours of twelve o'clock (12:00) midnight and twelve o'clock (12:00) noon from November 1 to March 31.

FIRE HYDRANTS NOTICE

Beginning October 1st, the City will be flushing out the fire hydrants. Because of this, some of your water from the tap may appear to be dirty, or a darker color. Please simply let the water flow and it will clear up on its own. We apologize for any inconvenience this might cause.

CODE ENFORCEMENT NOTES



As outlined in the City Code **10.11.040 Section E-** Parking in the front yard is prohibited.

No portion of a front yard as stated in this title, except driveways, shall be used for the parking of automobiles or other vehicles. Exceptions to this code include areas developed as public parking, in conjunction with a permitted commercial use, or as otherwise permitted in accordance with SWMC 10.08.050.

I appreciate the many residents that call and request information about the City Code. It is a pleasure to meet with, and hear from, all of you. Many of these visits have generated complaints about a nuisance that may be in the community and by calling and requesting a visit from me, often helps avoid confusion. I continue to welcome these calls.

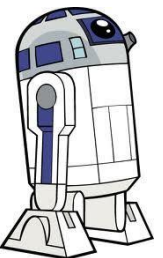

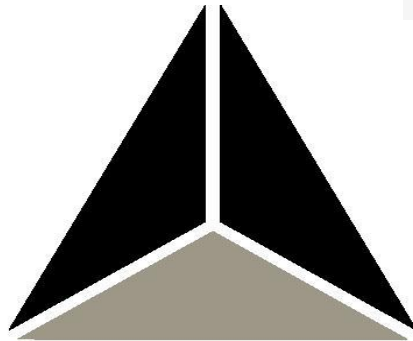
