### Winter Ordinances

#### Code 6.01.040(D):

**No on street parking from 12 midnight until 12 noon from November 1<sup>st</sup> through March 31<sup>st</sup>**

#### Code 7.01.020(A):

Keep sidewalks clear of snow, sleet or hail

#### Other Reminders:

Slow down in the school zones & watch for children & buses, get the snow blowers and plows serviced, check rain gutters & fireplace chimneys.

### REMINDER

#### **DON'T FORGET:**

It is unlawful for any person to deposit or blow snow, or any other material, onto the street!

### Attention all South Weber Business Owners!

All 2015 business licenses expired on December 31, 2015. If you have not received your 2016 license in the mail yet, you have either not paid or still need a fire inspection.

If a fire inspection is necessary for the renewal, please schedule one by calling City Hall. Please be aware that a 50% penalty will

be assessed to the license fee for any business license renewal which has not been paid by February 1st, and a 100% penalty will be assessed to the fee for any business license renewal which has not been paid by March 1st.
